



RIM Hosts Third Annual Food Drive

LOS ANGELES – February 28, 2010 – Regional Investment & Management (RIM) hosted its third annual food drive, raising awareness in its communities on the issue of hunger. Over 2,000 pounds of food were donated by residents in RIM communities during December '09, up from their donation of approximately 1,200 pounds of food in '08.

RIM partners annually with the San Antonio Food Bank and the North Texas Food Bank of Dallas, organizing food drives for resident participation. The food donated provides needed supplies to: shelters, after school programs, soup kitchens, low-income daycare centers and senior citizen shelters.

According to the San Antonio Food Bank, an estimated 36.2 million Americans suffer from hunger. Texas leads the nation with the highest percentage of families who are food insecure and RIM is taking an active role to end hunger. Over 5 million meals are served between the San Antonio and North Dallas Food Banks.

The company also provides the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank with professional and financial support in which Rosey Miller, RIM's President and CEO, serves on the board of directors.
